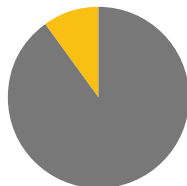

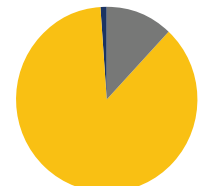
Do you believe that legislators should be allowed to draw the legislative district maps that decide who their voters will be?

0% Did not vote



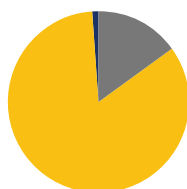
Do you think that Hoosiers should be able to take paid time off work to care for a sick child or family member?

1% Did not vote



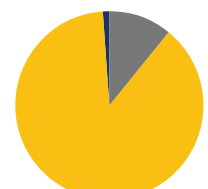

1% Did not vote



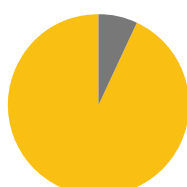
Do you think that DCS case workers should be able to receive student loan assistance after working in the position for a minimum of three years to help fulfill Indiana's need for additional case workers?

1% Did not vote



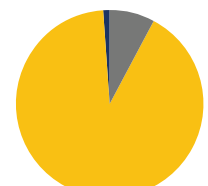
Do you think that public school teachers should receive an increase in their salaries to help combat the teacher shortage issue in Indiana?
